

SAFETY AND REPORTING POLICY


Safety is to be considered over all other factors in all risk management processes.

As President and Accountable Executive, I accept ultimate responsibility for all aspects of safety at the Carson Group of Companies, including Carson Air, Southern Interior Flight Centre, and the Kelowna and Abbotsford Shell Aerocentres. (The Company)

Employees at all levels are required to take preventative safety action, and to immediately inform their supervisor if they are aware of any immediate safety threat to themselves or others. All employees must be aware that the Company will not initiate disciplinary action against any employee who reports an incident or an occurrence involving safety of flight, or risks to any person. This policy cannot be applied to any wilful, intentional, unlawful or criminal acts.

The Company has developed forms to report incidents, accidents or hazards. These are available to all employees, and all employees are encouraged and required to report any safety concerns or risks. All possible steps will be taken to protect the identity of the employee who submitted the report.
